

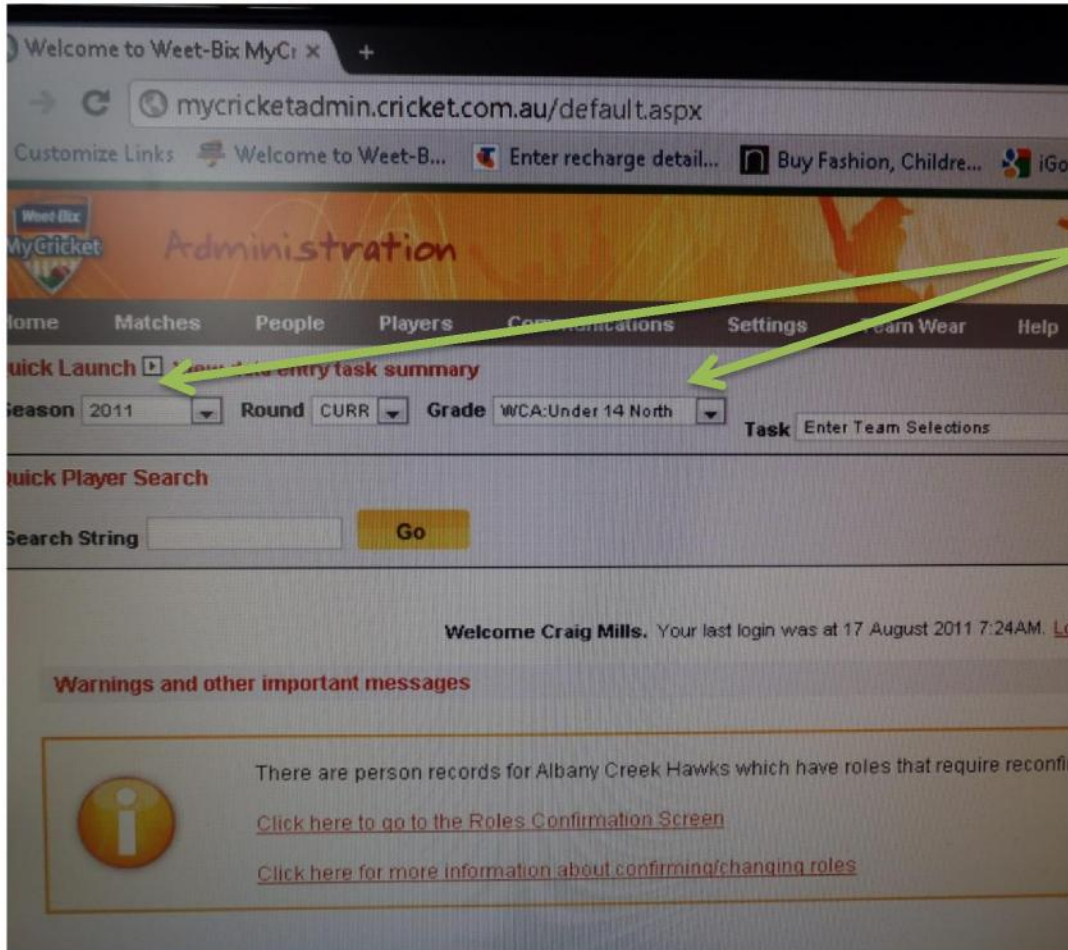

Be aware that if you click the remember me button on a shared computer other people will have access to the Admin site.

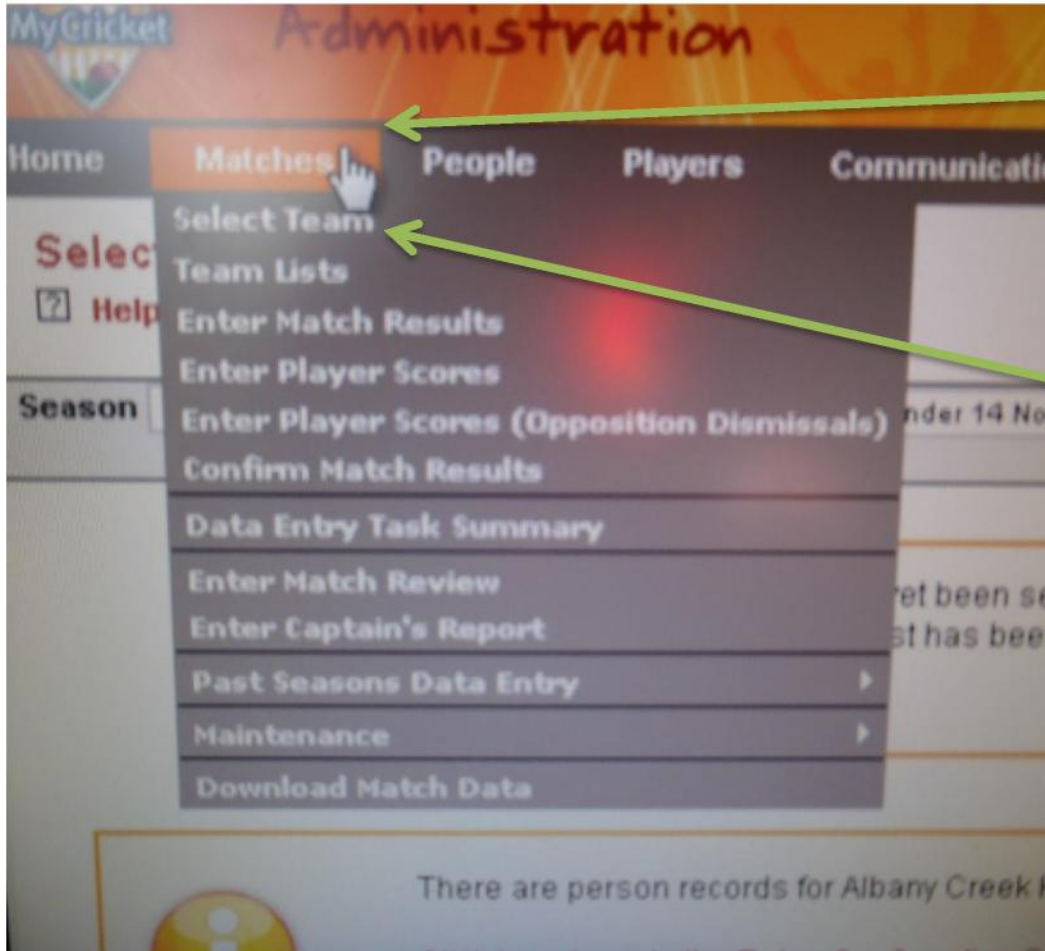
# Menu Bar

From this screen you have access to player information and match records.

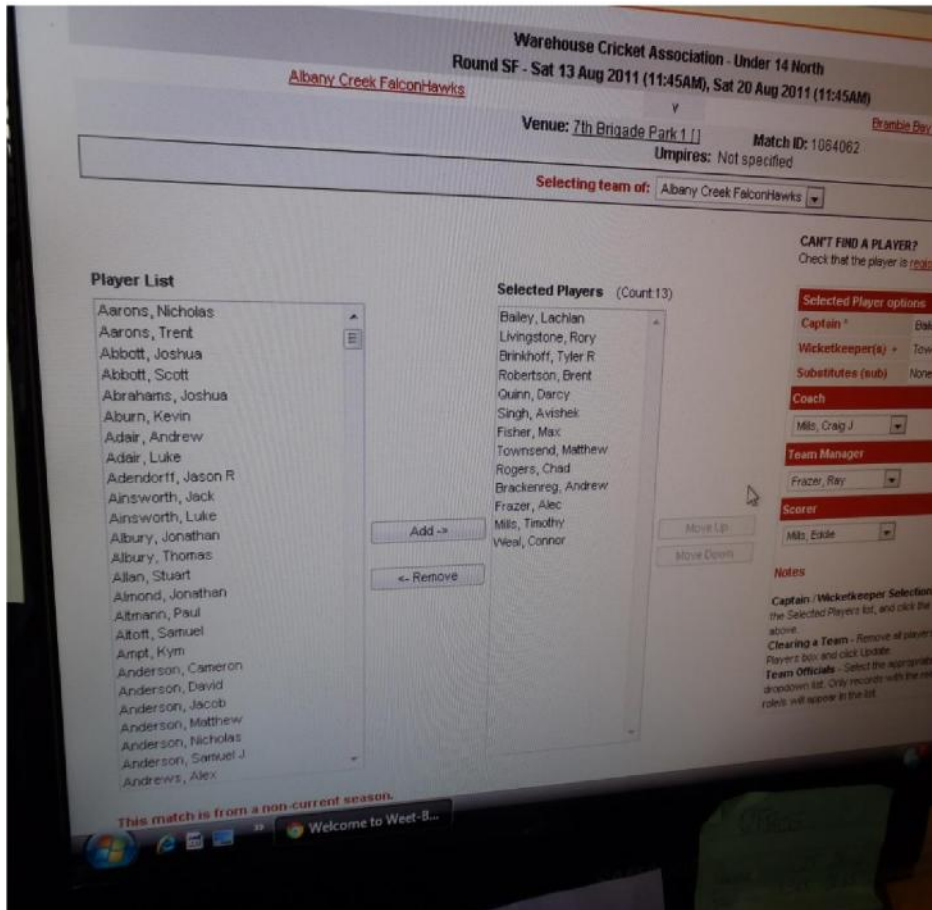
# Select Teams



On the Grey Bar hold the mouse over **MATCHES** to view the drop down options.

In order to enter your team list click **SELECT TEAM**

# Team List



To first set up your player list scroll down the provided **PLAYER LIST** on the left and click on the player you wish to add. Once selected click on **ADD** and the player name will be moved to **SELECTED PLAYERS**. Once all players are added you can use the **MOVE UP** or **MOVE DOWN** button to establish the batting order, by doing this it will be much easier to enter player scores.

**Captain / Wicketkeeper Selection** - Select the player in the Selected Players list, and click the appropriate Set link above.

**Clearing a Team** - Remove all players from the Selected Players box and click Update.

**Team Officials** - Select the appropriate name from the dropdown list. Only records with the relevant Team Official role/s will appear in the list.

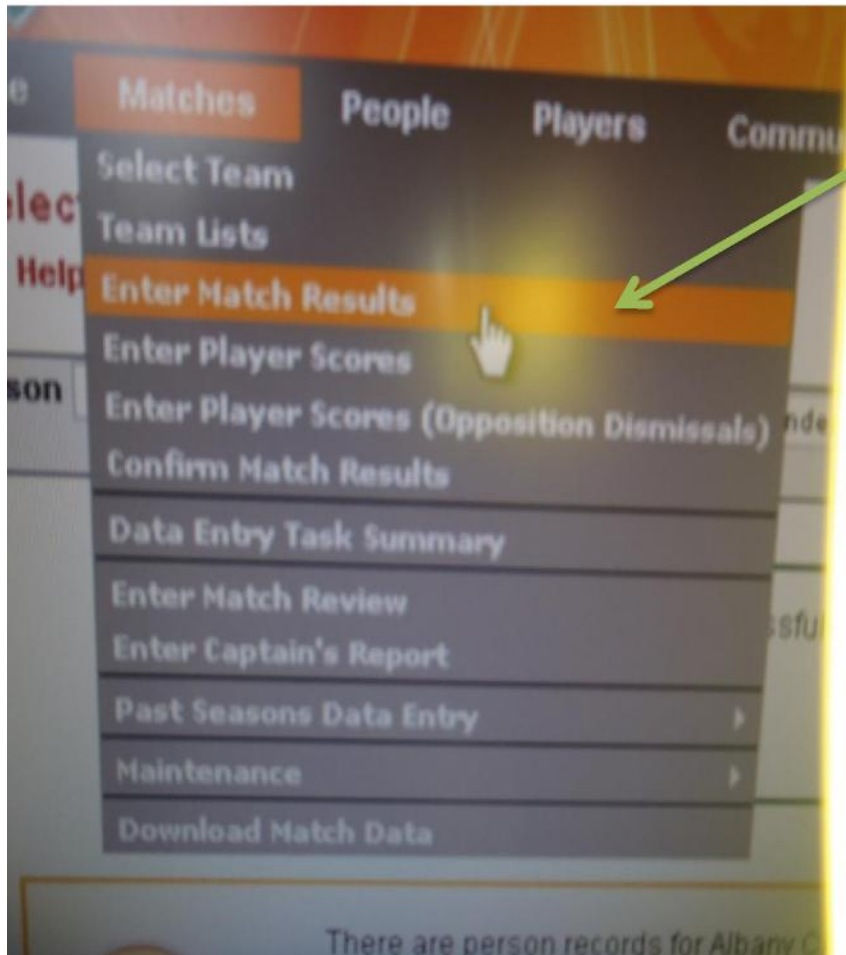

Be mindful that when you assign a player as substitute that player can only field. No batting or bowling statistics can be entered for this player. It is best to leave this position blank.



# Enter Match Results



Select **ENTER MATCH RESULTS** from **MATCHES** on the grey bar.

Please be aware that once you have entered the result and saved it the opposition can't change the entry. This is the same for you should the opposition enter the result.

Click the **INNINGS COMMENCED** box and enter Innings Result for each team as per score book, including Extras/Sundries accumulated by the bowling team for the particular innings. Be aware that it is imperative to enter the correct totals for each of the sundries. Failure to do so will cause error messages when entering the player scores.

For 2 day matches both Innings have to be entered if they were played. You can also enter a progress result for the match if it is a 2 day game.

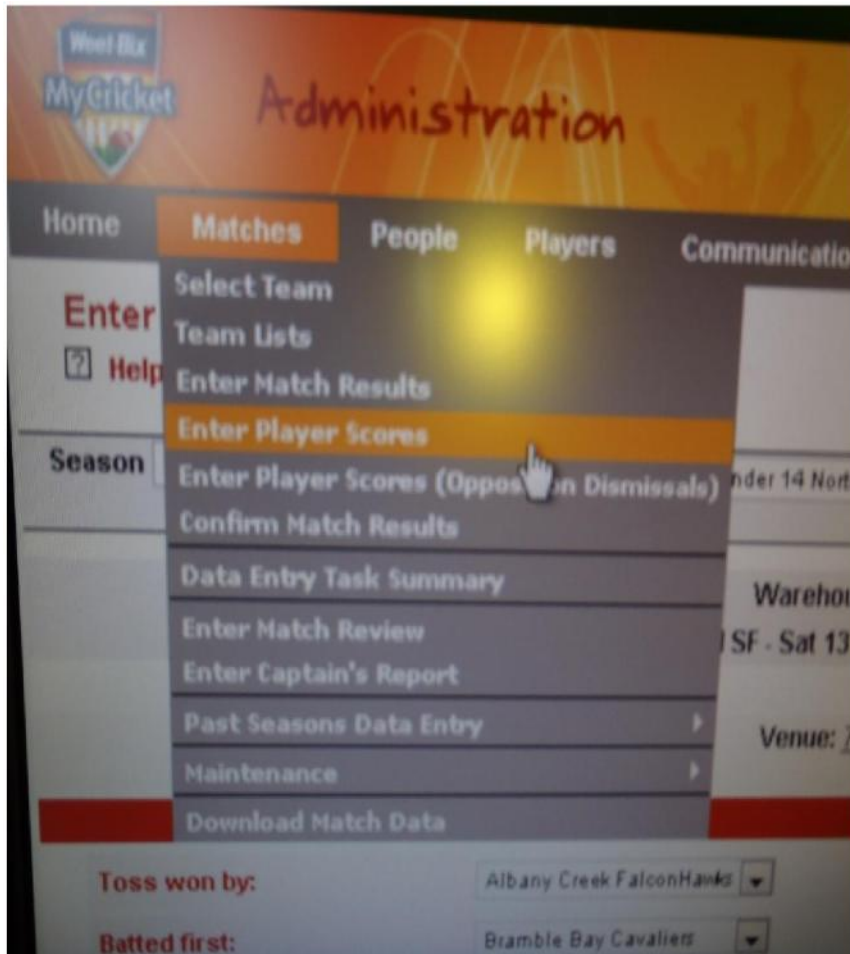

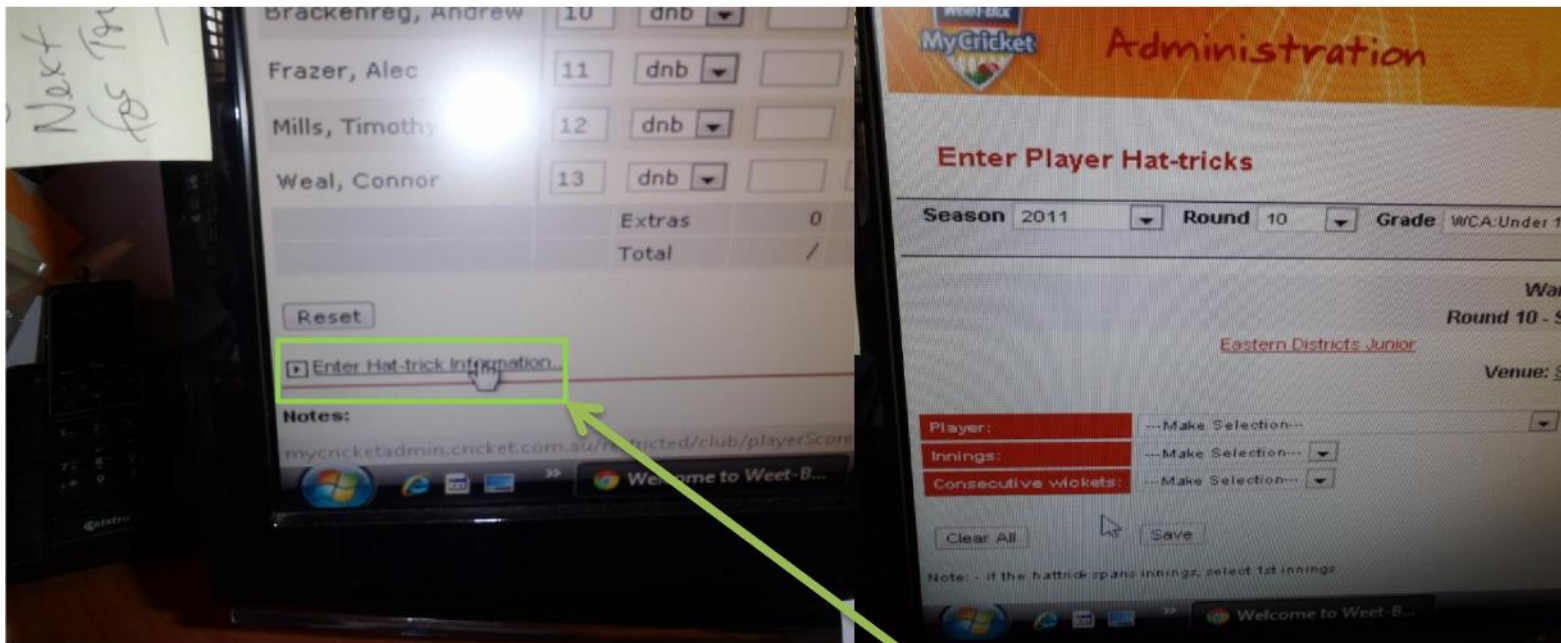



To enter Hat-trick information please click the link in the left-hand bottom corner below the batting line-up and follow the prompts.



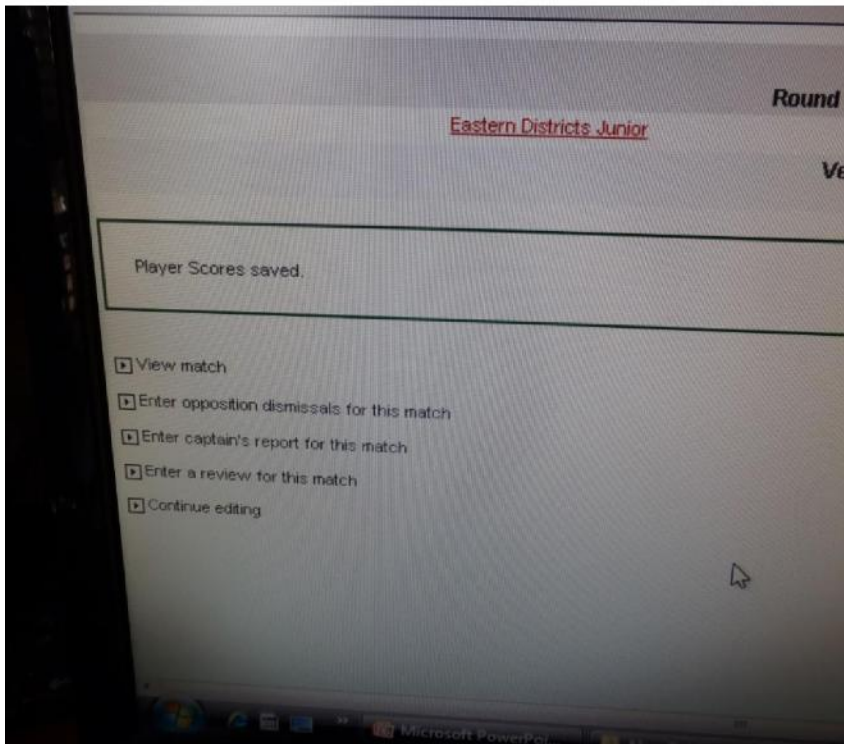

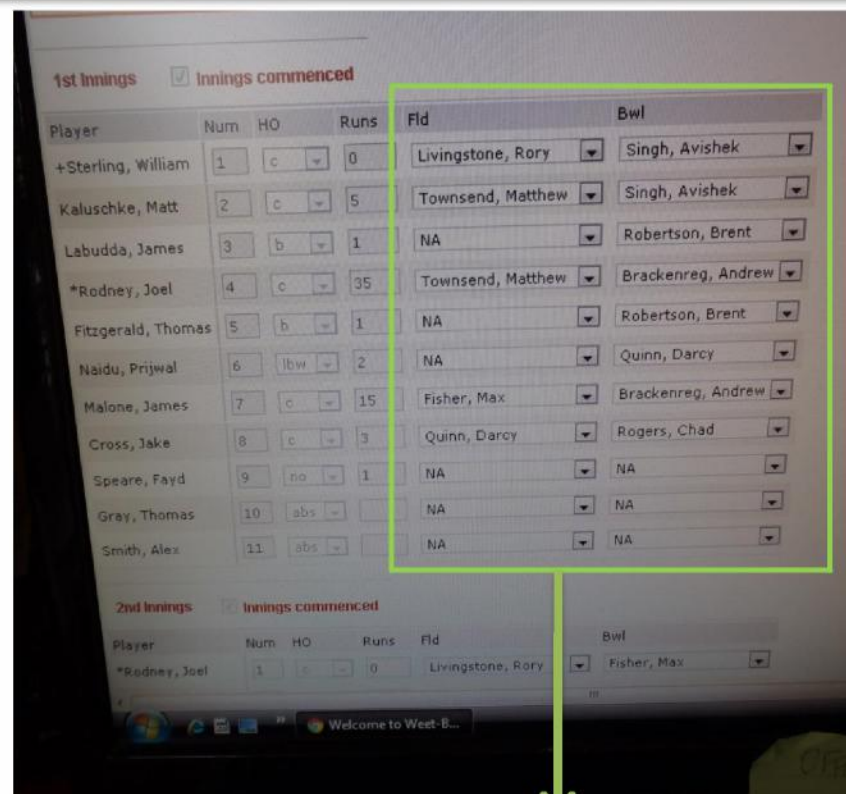
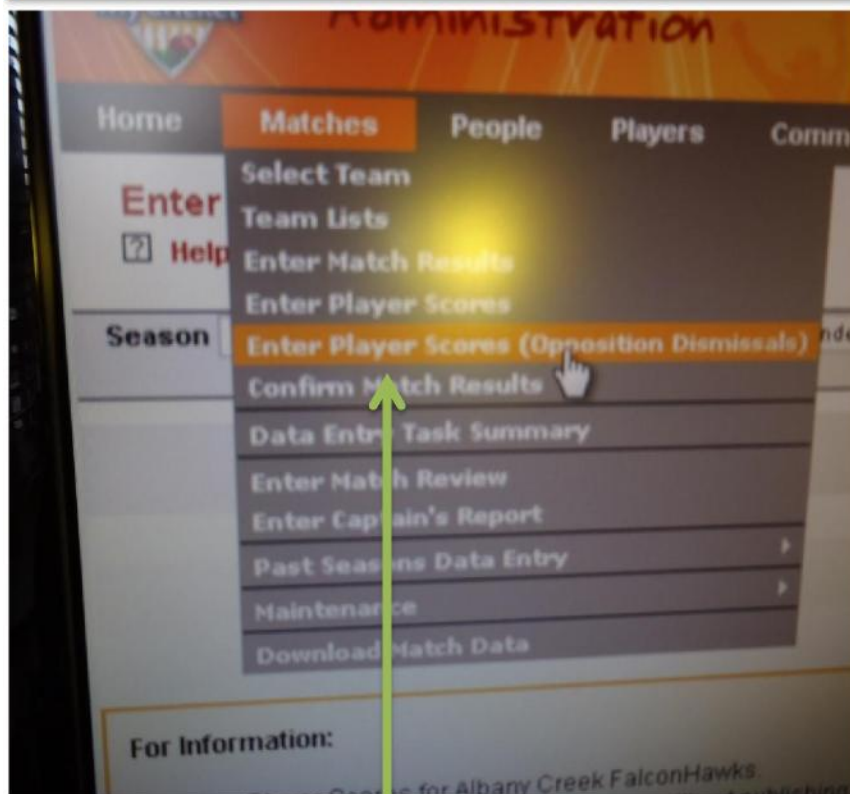

Once player results are updated you will see the confirmation screen and are given options on what to do next.

# Enter Opposition Dismissals



From the grey drop down link select the option and then enter Fielder and Bowler for each opposition batsman as per scorebook. This is only possible if the opposition has entered their player scores. Ensure to click update when done.

# Rules to follow

- Ensure that all entries are accurate and correct.
- Scorebooks must be balanced with the opposition at the end of each game and scores must be agreed upon.
- Scorebooks should be initialled by both scorers.
- Communication between scorers is imperative to avoid disputes about the outcome of a game.
- The information entered into **mycricket** forms the database from which the club statistician collects the data that determines the club award recipients at the end of each season.
- Match results and player scores should be entered by latest Tuesday after each game.
